- Improved Lighting: Modern LED lighting will be installed to enable evening and nighttime use, making the facility more accessible for various schedules.
- Accessibility Features: The new design will incorporate accessibility features to ensure that people of all abilities can enjoy the facility.
- Year-Round Usage: The covered design will protect the facility from rain and sun, allowing for continuous use throughout the year, regardless of weather conditions.



The sport box project is budgeted at \$4.9 million. \$2 million comes from a grant the District of Central Saanich received from the Federal Government Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program. The remaining \$2.9 million from the Peninsula Recreation Commission (PRC) Capital Plan which is part of the Capital Regional District (CRD) financial plan. Opening Spring 2025
