a) Oxygenation System

Stuart provided an update on the oxygenation system. He mentioned that the building is completed and we are just waiting on final specs from the consultant. The system will be monitored to see how it is working at the lake. Adjustments will be needed based on the operating levels. He pointed out that if the bubbles are going to be a problem for rowing regattas then the system can be turned off temporarily. Noticed blue green algae this year and the system should make a difference but will take some time.
