1. Welcome

A. Bergner provided a presentation on Solid Waste Management Planning, including Guiding Principles, steps taken in creating a solid waste management plan (SWMP), and the work done to-date on Revision 3 of the CRD SWMP

R. Smith advised that there will be a tour of solid waste facilities at the beginning of May, dates to be confirmed.
