

PERMIT APPLICATION FOR DISPOSAL OF CLEAN DEMOLITION WASTE

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Demolition and renovation waste is only accepted at Hartland Landfill with an approved permit issued by the Capital Regional District (CRD). Contaminated demolition and renovation waste is prohibited from disposal.
- 2. Evaluation of this application may take up to three business days.
- 3. Hazardous materials assessment surveys and supporting analytical data must be submitted for all demolition and renovation waste destined for the landfill.
- 4. The following is required prior to permit issuance:
 - Hazardous materials assessment
 - TCLP for leachable lead (where there is lead paint present)
 - Confirmation of abatement document including air clearance if applicable
- 5. Per Bylaw No. 3881, Hartland Tipping Fee and Regulation Bylaw, all prohibited and recyclable materials must be removed, including but not limited to: drywall, metal, asbestos, PCBs, etc.
- 6. Once the permit is issued, a disposal appointment must be made by calling: **250.360.3410**.
- 7. The person/company hauling the waste must bring a copy of the clean demolition waste permit with the Waste Carrier Section completed for each disposal appointment.
- 8. Permitted wastes are accepted at the landfill, by appointment only, Monday to Friday between the hours of 9 am and 5 pm. **A minimum of 24 hours notice is generally required.**
