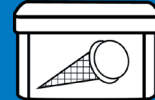

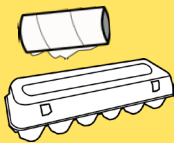

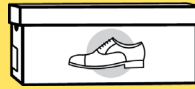
Cereal boxes

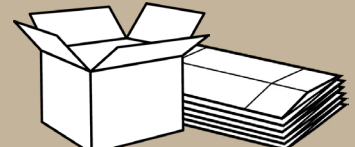


Shoe/product boxes

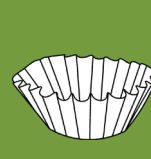

## Garbage

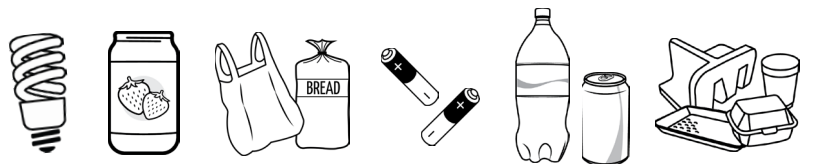


### Garbage Examples:
